The SUN Always Rises Bloody Mary mix is based on that first-ever Bloody Mary from Harry's New York Bar in Paris when Hemingway frequented the bar along with Pablo Picasso, F. Scott Fitzgerald and Gertrude Stein. The recipe is as big and bold as the man himself, with a dash of Dijon as a salute to France.

DIRECTIONS:

Mix $\frac{1}{2}$ SUN Always Rises with $\frac{1}{2}$ Grey Goose Vodka and pour into a container with ice and shake well. Salt the rims of tall glasses with The Flavors of Ernest Hemingway's the SEA SALT, pour your Bloody Mary, and garnish with a thick strip of fried bacon.
